7 OUT OF 10 New Zealanders have experienced a cyber security issue

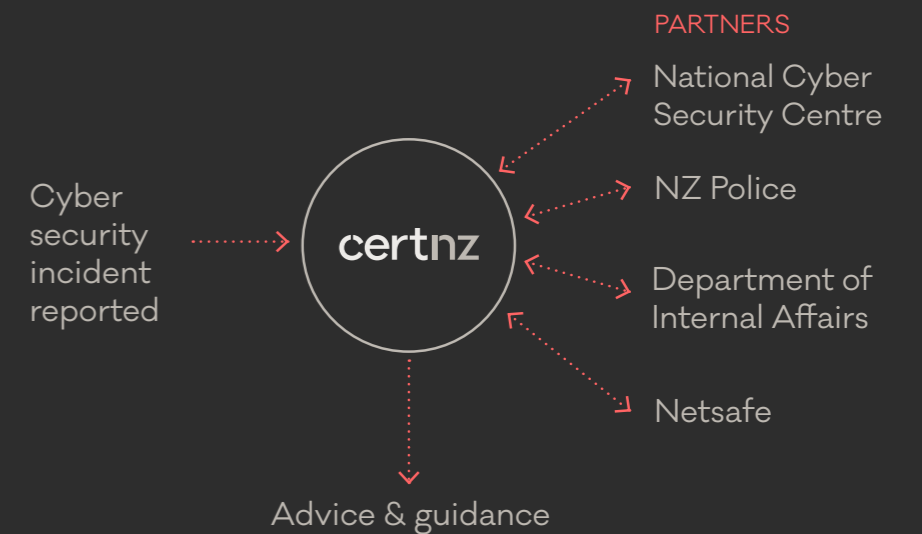

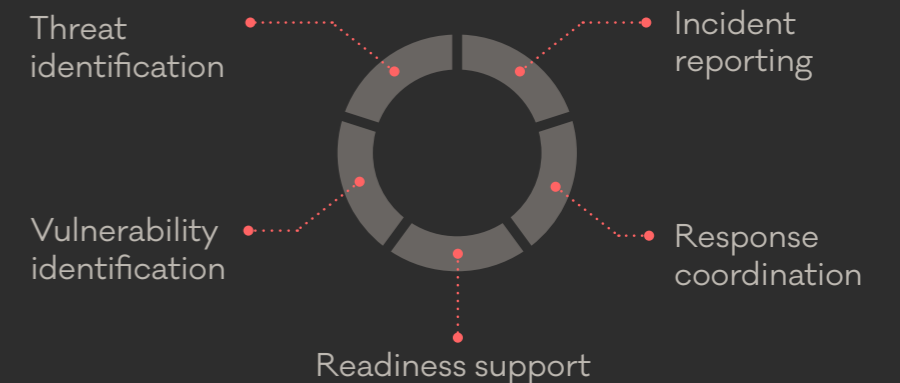
